As a non-profit continuing care retirement community, Deerfield has been delivering quality care and services since its founding in 1955.

Located on 125 lush, green acres just south of downtown Asheville, Deerfield offers a full range of options for Independent Living, Assisted Living and Skilled Nursing care in the Simonds Health Care Center. The Health Care Center also provides recuperative, long or short-term nursing care.

Living at Deerfield means vibrant, stimulating surroundings, activity-filled days and nights, and the peace of mind that comes with a full continuum of care. Our Wellness Center features a café/deli with a gathering area for casual dining and meetings, The Riverwalk Spa, the Deerfield clinic, exercise rooms, and dedicated spaces for art and craft activities.





ASSISTED LIVING at HADEN HALL

Haden Hall Assisted Living offers 62 apartments, including 20 large suites. Residents receive support with daily living needs, including monitoring of medications. Each of our suites includes a living room, a bedroom, an efficiency kitchen with refrigerator, sink and microwave oven, and a fully handicapped-accessible bathroom.

Light and airy, with nine-foot ceilings, the suites offer freedom from maintaining a household, while retaining the feeling of home. Residents make themselves at home with their own furniture, pictures and plants, and enjoy three meals daily served in a beautiful dining room with long range views overlooking the mountains to the east. There's a full activity calendar, including dining out at local restaurants, bridge, stretch aerobics, classes in the Aquatic Center and local shopping trips on selected days.





The SIMONDS HEALTH CARE CENTER

Built in a comfortable, neighborhood-inspired design, Deerfield's Simonds Health Care Center has 62 rooms offering 24-hour care to residents, with cozy sitting areas, living rooms and common spaces. A sunny outdoor courtyard provides a secure, enclosed space for gardening, pet therapy, sipping iced tea in the sunshine, or just watching birds flock to the feeders. Activities include movies, trips, discussion groups, social events, and stimulating musical programs. Church services are conducted in the innovative St. Giles Health Care Chapel by Deerfield's chaplain on Sundays and Wednesdays.

To assure that our high standards of quality care are maintained, all areas of the Health Center are under the direct supervision of a licensed administrator, Director of Nursing, and Medical Director, a licensed physician. The Health Care Center is a Medicare-approved facility.





ON-SITE THERAPIES

Deerfield's Wellness Center houses a specially designed area for physical, occupational and speech therapies. Residents enjoy the convenience of being able to work with licensed therapists on site.

The Aquatic Center contains a warm water therapy pool, as well as a lap-swimming pool.


MAHEC

Deerfield partners with MAHEC (Mountain Area Health and Education Center) to provide residents with on-site physician care. Through this partnership, residents have access to a professional staff of providers to meet their health care needs. The Deerfield clinic is staffed five mornings a week, Monday through Friday. In addition, there is a weekly Coumadin Clinic to monitor anti-coagulation therapy with a Pharmacotherapist.

AMENITIES

Fees include three meals a day, transportation, house-keeping and maintenance services, activities, utilities (except telephone and cable TV), and nursing care.


ADMISSION POLICIES

Deerfield offers limited direct admission based on residence availability.

Prospective Assisted Living residents sign up using a Future Residency form accompanied by a \$1,000 fee which is refunded if the applicant does not move to Deerfield.

- 1. Applicants complete and return forms which cover personal history, health and financial status.
- Once approved for admission, prospective residents are placed on a wait list and contacted when space is available.
- Prior to admission, a medical history must be provided by the applicant's physician based on a recent physical.
- 4. Upon admission, the resident pays an admission fee and begins paying the monthly fees.

Deerfield is a Medicare-approved facility.
