70 Years of Storytelling:

Danny Boone's Legacy



Who would show up with tire chains and kitty litter during a snowstorm to help a stranded trucker? Only Danny Boone.

Whether he was digging out cars, shuttling nurses to work in the snow, or quietly slipping a few dollars to a coworker in need, Danny was always the one you could count on. He joined Deerfield in 1981 as a 23-year-old intern and spent the next 18 years leading with humility, humor, and heart - eventually serving as Acting Executive Director. Danny believed in doing

the right thing, even when no one was watching. He once gave up a beach vacation so an employee could replace their car. He never looked for recognition, he simply showed up for others, again and again.

After his passing in 2000 at just 41 years old, his wife Melonie Boone and longtime colleague Shirley Burnette helped create the Danny Boone Scholarship Fund, honoring his legacy of helping others by helping employees pursue their educational goals. Over the years, dozens of Deerfield team members have gone on to become nurses, healthcare professionals, and leaders thanks to this support.

This semester, the fund is supporting five outstanding employees - four studying healthcare and one pursuing an MBA.

With the help of Melonie, Shirley Burnette, the committee members, and generous residents alike, Danny's legacy is alive and well, woven into the fabric of this community he helped build.

If you'd like to support the scholarship that carries his name, your gift makes a difference and helps keep Danny's spirit of generosity going strong.


As part of Deerfield's 70th anniversary celebration, the Deerfield Archival

We are proud to share that Deerfield Volunteers alongside Deerfield Charitable Foundation were recently recognized with Meals on Wheels of Asheville and Buncombe County's inaugural **Becky Blalock Service and Generosity Award**. Presented on May 28, 2025, this meaningful honor celebrates the deep and lasting impact Deerfield residents and the Foundation have made in support of local seniors.

This award is a reflection of over **25 years of volunteerism** by Deerfield residents and the ongoing partnership between Meals on Wheels and the Deerfield Charitable Foundation. In the past year alone, following the devastation of Hurricane Helene, the Foundation granted **\$150,000** to help the organization recover and expand services—enabling three new delivery routes to be added for homebound seniors in Buncombe County.

In addition to financial support, Deerfield continues to strengthen its volunteer efforts. On **June 9**, MaRita Alexander of Meals on Wheels led a special training and information session for residents interested in volunteering. It was an inspiring afternoon full of learning, laughter, and

stories of impact.

As Deerfield celebrates 70 years of community and compassion, this recognition from Meals on Wheels reaffirms our commitment to ensuring that seniors in our wider community receive the care, nourishment, and human connection they deserve. Maximize Your Giving, Minimize Your Taxes!


